This week, in the midst of summer, the scriptures greet us with joy, peace, mercy, and more peace! Sounds a little like Advent, doesn't it? We often associate the prophet Isaiah with that preparatory season, and our first reading rings with such words as exult, comfort, and rejoice. The Israelites had reason to rejoice, for they had returned, come home, to a rebuilt Jerusalem from their exile in Babylon.

In the Gospel, the seventy-two disciples who were sent out have their own homecoming, returning to Jesus from spreading the Good News of the Kingdom and preparing people for the advent of Jesus into their cities and towns on his long road to Jerusalem. Like the exiles in Isaiah, the disciples return rejoicing.

The Good News, the Kingdom of God, is coming, even in summer. As today's psalm reminds us, "Shout joyfully to God, all the earth!"

Los israelitas tenían motivos para regocijarse, porque habían regresado, habían regresado a casa, a una Jerusalén reconstruida desde su exilio en Babilonia.

En el Evangelio, los setenta y dos discípulos que fueron enviados tienen su propio "regreso a casa", regresando a Jesús después de difundir la Buena Nueva del Reino y preparar a la gente para el "adviento" de Jesús a sus ciudades y pueblos en Su largo camino a Jerusalén. Como los exiliados en Isaías, los discípulos regresan regocijados.

La Buena Nueva, el Reino de Dios, está llegando, incluso en verano. Como el salmo de hoy nos recuerda: "¡Grita de alegría a Dios, a toda la tierra!"

Catholic Bible Institute

The Catholic Bible Institute (CBI) is a three-year, comprehensive Bible study program: one year focuses on the Old Testament, one on the New Testament, and a third on biblical themes, along with practical skills for facilitating Bible-based programs in parishes.

The goal of CBI is growth in missionary discipleship of Jesus through the Bible. CBI participants study the Word of God according to Catholic principles, connect the Word with life, and pray with the Word.

CBI learning entails:

- Presentations from a wide range of Bible scholars and experts
- Small-group conversation
- Reading assignments from the Bible and Bible commentaries
- Writing assignments (short reflection papers and one longer synthesis paper)
- Small group prayer with the Bible (lectio divina)
- Mentoring by a team of facilitators

Participants can opt for the Certification-Track to earn a Certificate in Bible Study Leadership from the Archdiocese of Los Angeles (and LMU Extension Semester Hours), or they can participate simply for their own learning in the Enrichment-Track.

CBI meets one Saturday a month, August through June, from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. at Incarnation Church in Glendale.

CBI tuition is \$380 per year for Old and New Testament years. Payment in installments is available.

Know the ways predators groom children

One of the ways a predator grooms his potential victims is by allowing children to do things their parents wouldn't — anything from playing video games, seeing R or PG-13 rated movies, or trying drugs and alcohol. To children, it can be exciting or tempting when another adult says they get to do something they want to do and have been previously denied. For the predator, this begins to set up a perceived relationship in which the predator becomes a trusted ally to whom the child can turn. Parents should be aware of who their children spend time with, and what they do together. Gifts from an IRA

If you are 70 ½ or older, you can make a tax-free gift directly from your IRA account to the parish. This law allows you to transfer any amount up to \$100,000 annually directly to a qualified charitable organization without paying income tax on the distribution. The transfer does not generate taxable income or a tax deduction, so you benefit even if you do not itemize your tax deductions. Your gift can satisfy all or part of your required minimum distribution.

Gifts of Stock

Gifts of appreciated assets such as stock are an excellent way for you to make a charitable gift.

Stocks may be transferred directly to the Archdiocese for the benefit of parish, school or favorite Catholic ministry. These gifts will not affect your cash flow, and they provide the following tax benefits:

- A possible charitable deduction to help you save on taxes
- Bypass of federal and state capital gains taxes
- Avoidance of the tax on net investment income
