

Jubilee Year of Mercy

July 17th 2016
16th Sunday in Ordinary Time

Last Sunday's "Good Samaritan" parable concluded with Jesus' command: Go provide hands-on mercy to the next person you meet, no conditions, no limits, no exceptions. But today, Jesus seems to criticize Martha's hands-on mercy of hospitality, while praising Mary's "hands-off" as "choosing the better part" (Luke 10:42). Mary sat listening (10:39), leaving Martha "burdened with much serving by herself" (10:40). So, is the contemplative life of prayerful silence "superior," but the active life of earning a living, raising a family, running parishes, schools, hospitals, and social service ministries "second-class" discipleship? No; Jesus' example is not either/or but both/and: silent communion with God, boundless compassion for people. If we do not seek Jesus in silent prayer, how will we find Jesus in all others? If we do not serve Jesus in others, will our worship, despite its beauty, be anything but empty ritual? This Jubilee Year of Mercy offers us Jesus' two-fold challenge: both "go and do" and "sit and listen."

The Gospel for this Sunday can sometimes give the impression that Jesus favored Mary over Martha. But if they had both sat down to listen, there would have been no dinner to serve to Jesus. He saw that Mary was content to listen to him, so Martha could have been content to prepare the meal for him. Remember the first reading, in which Abraham insisted on serving the visitors, whom he came to recognize as the Lord and two angels. He was rewarded with the assurance that he would soon have a son. So simple acts of hospitality can also be how people can welcome the Lord into their homes. When we welcome someone into our homes as a visitor, or into our lives as a friend, we are also welcoming Christ. When we get to know someone better, we are also getting to know Christ. And what about that "better part" that Mary had chosen? Are we sometimes like Martha, with too many things on our minds to be aware of the Lord? Sometimes we can't avoid the distractions that are part of life. But if we keep the Lord on our minds we may be able to see which are distractions to be put aside, and which are opportunities to serve the Lord in a different way. As we spend more time with the Lord in prayer, we begin to experience God's peace, which gives us the ability to choose the better part.

Pastor's Corner

El Evangelio de este domingo a veces puede dar la impresión de que Jesús favoreció María sobre Martha. Pero si ambos habían sentado a escuchar, no habría habido ninguna cena para servir a Jesús. El vio que María se conformó con escuchar a él, por lo que Martha podría haber sido contento para preparar la comida para él. Recuerde que la primera lectura, en el que Abraham insistió en atender a los visitantes, a los que llegó a reconocer como el Señor y dos ángeles. Fue recompensado con la seguridad de que pronto tendría un hijo. Así simples actos de hospitalidad también pueden ser como las personas pueden acoger al Señor en sus hogares. Cuando damos la bienvenida a alguien en nuestros hogares como un visitante, o en nuestras vidas como un amigo, también la bienvenida a Cristo. Cuando llegamos a conocer a alguien mejor, también estamos llegando a conocer a Cristo. Y qué decir de la "buena parte" que María había elegido? ¿Estamos a veces como Marta, con demasiadas cosas en nuestra mente que ser conscientes de que el Señor esta presente? A veces no podemos evitar las distracciones que son parte de la vida. Pero si mantenemos el Señor en nuestra mente podemos ser capaces de dejar de lado las distracciones, y ver que son oportunidades de servir al Señor de una manera diferente. A medida que pasan más tiempo con el Señor en la oración, comenzamos a experimentar la paz de Dios, que nos da la capacidad de elegir la mejor parte.
