**S**aint Ann Catholic Church was founded in 1937. A temporary church at the corner of Dorris and Blake Streets was obtained under the administration of Father William Schulte. In 1948 the cornerstone for a new building was blessed when Father Patrick Scott was Pastor. Monsignor Kenneth O'Brien followed as Pastor from 1955-1962. The tower of the church is one of the last in Los Angeles in Mission style (1948) before the Archdiocese began to build the same design everywhere to save time and money. The church is a charming church in its architecture and design. His successor was a pastor of Irish descent Monsignor John Bronson and he was pastor for 23 years. Another parish priest of Irish descent resided in administration (1986- 2000) Father Hugh Crowe. At this time Father Ted Ley was an associate priest but only for a short time since he was devoted to the Schola (choir school). Father Ted became a part time associate at little Saint Ann's near Downtown Los Angeles. Back then our little parish was quite busy for its size, with only 800 or so families. After Father Crowe retired, Father Ted Ley was named Administrator pro-tem. Saint Ann's was then twinned with Divine Saviour across the river and Father Marco Ortiz was named the Administrator. Since we were and still are an immigrant parish liturgically, with four languages and five major cultures, we have mass regularly in English, Spanish, Vietnamese and Thai. As well as the music at the English masses is bilingual in English and Tagalog (Filipino). We have a very representative parish council and finance committee, and there are also wonderful prayer groups. Until the death of our Pastor Emeritus Father Hugh Crowe, the Pastor used to live on the property. The people of Saint Ann's have said: "they love their parish because it is very beautiful." Moreover, it is, both in appearance and manner. We have all different classifications of society around us and as well as in the parish community. The community is a very diverse population. We have the Vietnamese, Thai, Filipino, the Latino, and the American community. Their pastor, together with the community have kept the church in great shape. Saint Ann is currently being served by the *Friar Servants of Mary*: Father Albert Pragasam, OSM and Father Samy Durai, OSM.

LA IGLESIA DE SANTA ANA  
POR SU 80<sup>A</sup> ANIVERSARIO**



**L**a Iglesia Católica de Santa Ana fue fundada en 1937. Una iglesia temporal en la esquina de las calles Dorris y Blake fue obtenida bajo la administración del Padre William Schulte. En 1948 la piedra angular para un nuevo edificio fue bendecida cuando el Padre Patrick Scott era Pastor. Monseñor Kenneth O'Brien siguió como Pastor de 1955-1962. La torre de la iglesia es una de las últimas en Los Angeles en el estilo de la Misión (1948) antes de que la Arquidiócesis comenzó a construir el mismo diseño en todas partes para ahorrar tiempo y dinero. La iglesia es una iglesia encantadora en su arquitectura y diseño. Su sucesor fue un pastor de ascendencia irlandesa Monseñor John Bronson y fue pastor durante 23 años. Otro párroco de ascendencia irlandesa residía en la administración (1986-2000) Padre Hugh Crowe. En este tiempo el padre Ted Ley era un sacerdote asociado, pero sólo por un corto tiempo desde que se dedicó a la Schola (escuela de coro). Padre Ted se convirtió en un asociado a tiempo parcial en la pequeña Saint Ann cerca del centro de Los Angeles. En aquel entonces nuestra pequeña parroquia estaba muy ocupada por su tamaño, con sólo 800 familias o más. Después de que el padre Crowe se retiró, el padre Ted Ley fue nombrado administrador. Saint Ann fue entonces hermanada con el Divino Salvador a través del río y el Padre Marco Ortiz fue nombrado Administrador. Dado que éramos y todavía somos una parroquia de inmigrantes litúrgicamente, con cuatro idiomas y cinco culturas principales, tenemos misa regularmente en inglés, español, vietnamita y tailandés. Así como la música en las misas es bilingüe en inglés y Tagalog (Filipino). Tenemos un consejo parroquial muy representativo y un comité de finanzas, y también hay grupos de oración maravillosos. Hasta la muerte de nuestro Pastor Emérito Padre Hugh Crowe, el Pastor solía vivir en la propiedad. La gente de Santa Ana ha dicho: "aman a su parroquia porque es muy hermosa". Además, lo es tanto en apariencia como en forma. Tenemos diferentes clasificaciones de la sociedad que nos rodea, así como en la comunidad parroquial. La comunidad es una población muy diversa. Tenemos la comunidad vietnamita, tailandesa, filipina, latina y americana. Su pastor, junto con la comunidad, han mantenido a la iglesia en gran forma. Santa Ana está siendo servida por los Hermanos de María: Padre Albert Pragasam, OSM y Padre Samy Durai, OSM.
